## Virtual Sports Gala





## Yoga Day




## Ambassador Of Healthy Life




## My Rainbow

## Stories In Stone: Totem Making






## Sunshine Kite







## Patriotic Poetry Competition



## Shape Run



## Hindi Diwas






## Indigenous Games

## Teachers Day





## Diwali Celebration



Experiential learning is an engaged learning process whereby students “learn by doing” and by reflecting on the experience.



Five senses here talk about what you hear, see, smell, taste, and touch.

“Christmas isn't a season. It's a feeling.”





The year round celebration in “The Millennium School Surat” culminated with the sound of the jingles, which is the celebration of Christmas on 23rd of December 2021.









To ensure that the students surge ahead in the right direction with our expert guidance, we arranged orientation for parents to know about learning gaps and the solutions to fill out the gaps.
